## How to Make: The Emotions Parking Lot

Emo	tions Parking Lot You will need the following materials:
	<ul> <li>A corrugated plastic board (32 x 53cm). You can also use a thick project board.</li> <li>Permanent marker</li> <li>Ruler</li> <li>Emotion cards – color printing</li> <li>Activity cards – color printing</li> <li>Laminating sheets and laminating machine</li> <li>Scissors</li> <li>Velcro pieces/Velcro dots, Funtak (optional)</li> <li>6-10 Miniature cars</li> <li>Caddy with compartments, basket or bin to keep all the cards and cars together</li> </ul>
Step 1	Preparing the game board
	<ul> <li>Mesure a top area for your title "Emotions Parking Lot." Write this in with a permanent marker</li> <li>On each side of the board, measure sections in which to "park" the "emotion photographs" and "activity cards." You should have 8-9 spaces on each side of the board.</li> <li>You may want to put Velcro pieces/Velcro dots in each of the parking areas. If you do so, then place a Velcro piece/Velcro dot on each of the emotion and activity cards.</li> <li>If you are using Velcro, also place a Velcro piece on the roof of each of the miniature cards. This will allow them to "carry" the cards safely as they travel in and around the parking lot, searching for the best place to park.</li> </ul>
Step 2	Preparing the emotion and activity cards
	<ul> <li>Please print these documents on a color printer, it will enhance the images and make this an attractive item in the game</li> <li>Laminate the sheets, then cut into individual card size</li> <li>If using Velcro pieces/Velcro dots, place a piece of the opposite Velcro texture than what has been placed on the board and the roofs of the miniature cars</li> <li>If not using Velcro, one can also use Funtak to hold the cards temporarily throughout the game.</li> </ul>
Step 3	Playing with the Emotions Parking Lot game
	<ul> <li>Please see the Video Capsule "Emotions Parking Lot Explained" to provide you with information, instructions and guidance.</li> <li>For safe-keeping and demonstrating good organizational skills, please keep all the cards and cars in a caddy or basket alongside the game board.</li> </ul>
